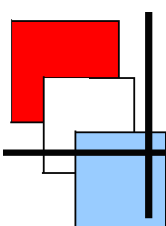

# ***MCCK goes LMCC***

## ***About the club:***

The club was founded as Model Car Club Kockelscheuer (MCCK) in 1991 and has now about 50 members.

In the past 17 years we organized over 200 national and international races in all the different classes: 1/8 IC track, Large Scale and 1/10 electric.

In Autumn 1999 we started with the construction of our track and the first race was run on the 21st of may 2000.

We hosted the EC 1/8 “B” IC track in 2002, the EC 1/5 touring car in 2003, the EC 1/8 “A” 2004 and the EC 1/5 touring car in 2008.

A new clubhouse was added in autumn 2005.

The track-layout was modified a year later.

In 2008, the club merged together with the Luxembourg Model Racing Team (LMRT) , one of the oldest clubs which was founded in 1981, and changed his name to LMCC, Luxembourg Model Car Club.

The Mini-Circuit “Ville de Luxembourg” is situated in a suburb of Luxembourg-City, the capital of Luxemburg, only 5 km from the city centre.

The track layout is very demanding, with a hairpin corner, fast chicanes, a “Laguna-Seca”- like downward chicane with 2 m level difference and a 10 ° banked curve.
